



## Youth Camera Action Check List

### Before the screening

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- Contact the NYCLU to tell them the date, time and location of your screening and request any assistance you need.

- Recruit local youth, educators, or activists to moderate the discussion following the screening.
- Publicize your event with flyers, emails, announcements at community organizations, religious institutions, and events. Make sure your flyers give the date, time and location of the screening.

- Pass out handouts on the issue.
