



## Student Safety Act Reporting on Arrests and Summonses

1<sup>st</sup> Quarter 2013

### GENERAL DATA

There were 363 arrests and summons – more than 6 per day. There were 55 school days during the first quarter of 2013 (Jan. 1 – March 31).
