



## Student Safety Act Reporting on Arrests and Summonses

1<sup>st</sup> Quarter 2014

### GENERAL DATA

There were 269 arrests and summonses – more than 4 per day. There were 55 high school and 57 middle school days during the first quarter of 2014 (Jan. 1 – March 31).
