STIPULATION AND ORDER OF SETTLEMENT

WHEREAS, petitioners the New York Civil Liberties Union ("NYCLU") and the American Civil Liberties Union ("ACLU") (collectively "Petitioners") sent a Freedom of Information Law ("FOIL") request to Respondent Village of Kiryas Joel ("the Village") in July 2013; and

WHEREAS, Petitioners commenced this action on December 10, 2013, seeking records responsive to Petitioners' July 2013 FOIL request; and

WHEREAS, the Village produced certain responsive records on January 17, 2014, and additional records on February 7, 2014; and

WHEREAS, the parties wish to settle the remainder of the case, including the Petitioners' claim to fees, expenses, and costs; and

NOW, THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED AND AGREED, by and between the undersigned attorneys for the NYCLU, the ACLU, and the Village, as follows:

- The Village shall pay reasonable attorneys' fees, expenses, and costs of THREE 1. THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$3,000.00) to Petitioners' counsel, New York Civil Liberties Union Foundation, within 15 days in settlement of the above-captioned matter.
- 2. The parties understand and agree that upon the Court's ordering of this Stipulation, the parties' obligations, rights and responsibilities under this Stipulation shall commence, and all remaining aspects of this action, including any claims for attorneys' fees, costs and expenses, shall be dismissed with prejudice. No appeal shall be taken from the Order.

I am writing to inform the New York Civil Liberties Union and the American Civil Liberties Union that the municipal government of the Village of Kiryas Joel does not have any policy of directing, endorsing, or enforcing illegal segregation on the basis of sex in public places or programs. In particular, the Village does not have any policy of directing, endorsing, or enforcing illegal segregation on the basis of sex in the Village's playground located off Larkin Drive in the Town of Monroe, also known as the "Kinder Park." Further, as a government entity, the Village does not have any plan or intention to adopt a policy that would direct, endorse, or enforce illegal segregation on the basis of sex in public places or programs. The Village respects the rights of individuals, including Village residents, to practice their religion and to exercise their religious freedoms and beliefs.
