



Student Safety Act Reporting on Arrests and Summonses 2nd Quarter 2015

GENERAL DATA

There were 151 arrests and summons – almost 3 per day. There were 54 high school days and 54 middle school days during the second quarter of 2015 (April 1 – June 30).
