Upon the Memorandum of Law in Support of Motion for Preliminary Injunction and Temporary Restraining Order; the Affirmation of Corey Stoughton, executed on May 18, 2010; and the affidavits of Nadia Marin and Luz Torres, executed on May 13, 2010; and the Complaint attached hereto it is hereby ORDERED that the above named Defendants show before this Court, at Room 930, United States Courthouse, 100 Federal Plaza, Central Islip, NY 11722-443, on 100 April 200, at 200, or as soon thereafter as counsel may be heard, why an order should not be issued pursuant to Rule 65(b) of the Federal Rules Of Civil Procedure granting a preliminary injunction staying enforcement of Chapter 205.32 of the Code of the Town of Oyster Bay.
