

SSA Reporting on Arrests and Summonses

4th Quarter 2011

GENERAL DATA

If you count arrests, summonses, and non-criminal incidents, there were 2,286 incidents - more than 41 per day. There are 55 school days during the 4th quarter reporting (Oct. 1- Dec. 31).
