

## Student Safety Act Reporting on Arrests and Summonses

3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter 2014

## **GENERAL DATA**

There were 145 arrests and summons — more than 3 per day. There were 45 high school and 39 middle school days during the third quarter of 2014 (July 1 — September 30).
