

These services are confidential. No one at the clinic or doctor's office can tell anyone when or why you came in, unless you say so.

- Sexual Assault Care
 - Abortion Services
 - HIV Tests
 - STI (Sexually Transmitted Infection) Tests and Care
 - Pregnancy Tests and Prenatal Care
 - Emergency Contraception (the "Morning-After Pill")
 - Birth Control (like condoms and the Pill)
- You don't need permission from your parents, boyfriend, girlfriend, or anyone else to get these services.
