

- #9(f): Records relating to disposition of charges are held by the court system, not RPD
- #14: Any records relating to license plate readers are held by Monroe County, not the RPD
- #19 through 22: RPD did not have or use body cameras during the period covered by NYCLU's request; however, please note that RPD hopes to implement body camera technology around June of 2016
- #23 through 24: RPD does not use facial recognition technology
- #27 through 29: RPD does not use predictive policing software
- #38 through 39: All training materials are maintained by the training center at Monroe Community College, not RPD

Of the other outstanding requests, items 10-18 are being investigated to determine whether there are any records meeting your demand. If there are relevant records, they will be retrieved and sent to you by March 1, 2016.

Further, due to RPD's unique closed electronic system for records relating to requests #4 & 8, which cannot be transmitted electronically, retrieval will require the RPD to print out a copy of each page of the records, hand-redact them, and re-photocopy the record in order to satisfy your request. These documents will be sent to you in paper form.

By estimation, there are approximately 900 incidents a year that would relate to request #4 with approximately 10 pages relating to each event. This totals approximately 9,000 pages of records for each year subject to your request, resulting in approximately 31,500 pages of documents. Due to the extensive volume of your request and the substantial resources that will be required by RPD (time, paper, ink, etc.), RPD requests that you send pre-payment for these records prior to preparation. Such payment is authorized by New York Public Officers Law § 87(1)(b)(iii) and (c) and supported by the Committee on Open Government's FOIL Advisory Opinions (see e.g. FOIL-AO-F8306). Upon receipt of \$7,875.00, RPD will complete your request within six months.

Regarding request #8, there are approximately 16,000 events each year that would relate to your request. Assuming most of the records are at least three pages long, RPD's best estimate is that there are approximately 168,000 records that would be subject to disclosure in the timeframe you have requested. Before processing these records, RPD requires a prepayment of \$42,000.00. Upon receipt of prepayment, RPD will complete your request within six months.
